November 11, 2025**

I. Call to Order

President Vytenis Kirvelaitis called the meeting to order at 6:46 p.m.

II. Roll Call

The following trustees answered present: Laura Burt-Nicholas, Patricia Camalliere, Melanie Grzesik-Duffy, Vytenis Kirvelaitis, Renee Miller, Catherine Sanders, and Michaeline Skibinski. Library Director Mary Golden was also present.

III. Public Comment

There were no members of the public in attendance.

IV. Discussion

Adoption of the annual tax levy ordinance allows the Library to capture all available property tax monies, including first-year growth. The Property Tax Extension Limitation Law (PTELL) limits taxing districts to an increase in property tax extensions on existing property of the lesser of 5.0% or the increase in the national Consumer Price Index. The actual taxes extended and collected have traditionally fallen below the estimate.

The estimated total property taxes to be levied for 2025-2026 are \$2,414,877. This represents a decrease of 0.5 percent from the previous year. The Board will vote on the ordinance during its regular meeting, directly after the hearing.

V. Adjournment

A motion was made by Trustee Camalliere and seconded by Trustee Skibinski to adjourn the meeting at 6:58 p.m. A roll call was taken. Trustees Burt-Nicholas, Camalliere, Grzesik-Duffy, Kirvelaitis, Miller, Sanders, and Skibinski voted aye. There were no nays. The motion passed. The meeting was adjourned.

RESOLUTION TO DETERMINE ESTIMATE OF FUNDS NEEDED FOR THE 2025/2026 FISCAL YEAR

WHEREAS the Lemont Public Library District must file on or before December 30, 2025, its Levy Ordinance for the 2025/2026 fiscal year; and


WHEREAS pursuant to the "Truth in Taxation Act" (35 ILCS 215/1 et.seq.), the Lemont Public Library District must determine not less than 20 days before the adoption of its Levy Ordinance the amounts of money to be raised by taxation for the 2025/2026 fiscal year upon the taxable property in said Library District.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND DETERMINED by the Board of Library Trustees of the Lemont Public Library District that the amount of money estimated to be necessary to be raised by taxation for the 2025/2026 fiscal year upon the taxable property in said Library District is \$2,414,877.

FURTHER RESOLVED that a public hearing pursuant to the Truth in Taxation Act shall be held on the 11th day of November at the Lemont Public Library, 50 E Wend St., Lemont, IL 60439.

FURTHER RESOLVED that notice of said public hearing in compliance with said ACT shall be given in a newspaper with circulation in the District, not more than 14 days nor less than 7 days prior to the date of the public hearing.

The estimated property tax to be levied for debt service and public building commission leases for 2025 is \$263,400. This represents a 6.8% decrease over the previous year.
